IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Hats and Body Protectors will be checked on arrival (see rule 5 below).
- **Print your own numbers in font size 300** and make **THREE** copies (1 for front of bib; 1 for back of bib and 1 for your vehicle).
- Failure to report to warm up arena 15 mins before the correct time will mean the rider risks elimination.
- A tack check will be in operation and hats can be tagged at the secretary if required.
- No ditches to be included in classes 1-4

To Start at approx 09:30

Class 1 – Mini Minimus (40cm)

SPONSORED BY STRANGE THE JEWELLERS

Fences no higher than 40cm (will be a shorter course in a single field. All competitors in this class can be assisted by voice/runner, but absolutely no lead reins allowed. Speed 350mpm

Section A: Hunter Trials - 9 yrs & under (age on day of event)

Section B: Hunter Trials - 10 yrs and over

Class 2 – Minimus

SPONSORED BY EDMUNDS ACCOUNTANCY

Fences range from 40cm up to maximum of 60cm. Speed 400mpm

Class 3 - Minimus Pairs

Fences range from 40cm up to maximum of 60cm and there will be 2 dressing fences. Speed 400mpm

Class 4 - PC70

Fences no higher than 70cm. Speed 435mpm

Entry Fee: £30.00 per person WPC Entry Fee: £28.00 per person

Class 5 - PC80

SPONSORED BY EDMUNDS ACCOUNTANCY

Fences no higher than 80cm. Speed 435mpm

Entry Fee: £30.00 per person WPC Entry Fee: £28.00 per person

Class 6 - PC 80 Pairs

Fences no higher than 80cm and there will be 2 dressing fences. Speed 435mpm

Entry Fee: £50.00 per pair WPC Entry Fee: £46.00 per pair

Class 7 - PC90

Fences no higher than 90cm. Speed 450mpm

Entry Fee: £30.00 per person WPC Entry Fee: £28.00 per person

JUDGING:

- The person nearest the OPTIMUM TIME in each class will be the winner based on the speed. Watches / stop watches are NOT TO BE WORN in any class.
- Each pairs class will have 2 dressing fences included, which will be clearly marked on the course plan. Riders will be expected to jump side by side. These will be marked by the jump judge (and are at the jump judge's discretion). If the pair jump these exactly side by side they will receive no penalties. The less in unison they are the more penalties they will receive, up to a maximum of 10 penalties per jump.
- Competitors will be eliminated after 3 refusals at one jump, after 4 refusals over whole course or 2 rider falls. Riders may only continue on the course with permission from a Wokingham Official steward.

PRIZES:

Rosettes to 6th Place in each class and section.

Rosettes to the Highest Placed Wokingham Member

Rosettes can be sent to you if you provide stamped addressed A4 Envelope on the day.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions, which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor.

- 1. **Health, Safety and Welfare**: The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
- 2. **Legal Liability**: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. **Entries are only accepted on this basis**.
- 3. This competition will be run in accordance with Pony Club Eventing Rules 2022. It is the responsibility of all competitors to know the rules. Please refer to the main Pony Club website for full rule book
- 4. No horse/pony may take part unless it has a Record of Vaccination against equine influenza which complies with the requirements set out in the 2022 rulebooks.
- 5. All riding hats/body protectors must conform to Pony Club Rules 2022. https://pcuk.org/officials/health-and-safety/dress-and-tack/ Hats must be tagged and riders must wear this at all times when mounted with the chinstrap fastened. Back protectors are compulsory. Air jackets must be used in conjunction with a back protector. No Jewellery is allowed. The Pony Club Saddlery and Dress rules will be strictly enforced.
- 6. Numbers will not be given out for Number Bibs. Print your own numbers in font size 300 TWO copies (1 for front of bib; 1 for back of bib). Ensure you bring your own number bib.
- 7. The judge's decision is <u>final in all matters</u>. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, add or amend any of the conditions or competitions, as they think fit and to refuse entry at their discretion. Any objection must be made to the secretary with a deposit of £15 not later than 30 minutes after the incident, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 8. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason for doing so and also reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places her/himself or others in danger or fails to observe rules.
- 9. Entry fees will only be refunded on production of a vet or doctor's certificate presented in advance of the competition.
- 10. Horses or ponies must be 5 years or over on the day of the show.
- 11. Horses & Ponies may only enter a maximum of 2 classes.
- 12. No Horses/ponies may be ridden other than by the competitor on the day of the competition.
- 13. No horses/ponies to be left unattended when tied to the lorry/trailer and all droppings to be picked up and taken home.
- 14. In the event of cancellation, notification will be posted on the Wokingham PC website. Monies will be refunded less £5.50 per entry administration fee.
- 15. Rosettes can be posted upon receipt of a large, 1st Class stamped addressed envelope.
- 16. We recommend medical armband are worn by unaccompanied riders, in case of an emergency.
