



Wheatlands Farm with James Turner Saddlery are excited to offer a 2-day residential equestrian camp on **Saturday 2nd and Sunday 3rd May 2026** at Wheatlands Farm. Set in 130 acres, Wheatlands Farm boasts fantastic facilities, including –

- A 60m x 30m waxed Activ-Track arena with a set of Jump for Joy Show Jumps
- A 50m x 25m waxed Activ-Track arena with mirrors.
- 20m x 20m waxed Ecotrack Lunge blend arena for lungeing/groundwork
- Cross Country courses with over 130 fences from 30cm to 1m, two water jumps, ditches and bank complexes.
- Grass dressage and showjumping
- A purpose-built and fully equipped clubhouse, with showers and toilets
- Temporary Cheval Liberte indoor barn-style stabling, including rubber matting floors.
- On site hacking in woods and fields



We aim to allow a 'pick and mix' approach to the ridden and non-ridden activities at the camp, however please note these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and spaces on some activities will be limited.

The camp will cost £200, which covers use of the facilities, your meals and some of the training options. Please note, some of the coaches will require a supplement to this price to cover their costs.

The coaches and activities we will be offering include –

Ridden and In-hand Activities



Russell MacKechnie-Guire - Founder of Centaur Biomechanics (2006), Russell has extensively researched how saddle fit, bridle design, and girth configuration affect equine welfare and performance. His current research focuses on the horse-saddle-rider interface, spinal kinematics during ridden work, and the effects of rider asymmetry on the equine back. **Russell will be offering Rider Analysis sessions.**

Amelia Collins - Amelia is a passionate and enthusiastic BHS Professional Accredited Coach and the founder of ACE Coaching (Amelia Collins Equestrian). She is dedicated to building confidence in riders of all levels, creating a supportive community for amateurs, professionals, young riders, and competitive riders alike. **Amelia will be offering 'confidence and competition prep', using jumping/gymnastic exercises/poles/XC schooling.**



Lindsey Dawes - Lindsey is a BD Accredited UKCC level 3 coach, a list 2 BD judge, BD Youth Assessor and coach and a Group 2 rider who has competed at Inter II. She trains clients of all levels many of whom have competed at TeamQuest, Area Festivals, Regionals, National championships and Premier League shows. **Lindsey will be offering dressage lessons.**

Nicola Greenwood - Nicola is a BHS Senior Accredited Coach in Complete Horsemanship and holds the UKCC3. She coaches adults and children at all levels, increasing confidence and competence, whilst helping them to achieve their individual goals. **Nicola will be offering jumping/gymnastic exercises/poles/XC schooling.**



Lucy Chester - Lucy specialises in horse behaviour (problem solving), liberty, trick-training and bitless and bridleless riding. She enjoys helping clients to understand and help their horses through the application of behavioural science and to strengthen their relationship through the use of positive reinforcement. **Lucy will be offering sessions to help strengthen your relationship with your horse with some agility work included.**

Non-ridden Activities

James Turner - James provides the Thames Valley area with a wide range of saddlery skills. He is a member of the Society of Master Saddlers and is a Qualified Saddle Fitter. James has a wealth of experience saddle fitting, as well as saddle alterations and all leather work repairs. **James will be offering saddle fitting advice and flocking during the camp at a discounted rate.**





Annabelle Evans - Equine BHSII and ITEC Diploma in Equine Massage Therapist and runs a rehabilitation yard in Liss, Hampshire. Annabelle Evans is a fully qualified and insured Equine Massage Therapist who has a calm and professional approach to her work and is dedicated in supporting her equine clients musculoskeletal system to maximize their performance and help prevent injury. Annabelle also offers session on her TheraPlate which provides non-invasive, low-amplitude orbital motion therapy (Vortex Wave Circulation) to enhance circulation, reduce inflammation, and accelerate healing in horses and pets. It effectively treats joint stiffness, soft tissue injuries, and muscle soreness while improving hoof growth, bone density, and relaxation. **Annabelle will be offering TheraPlate sessions and/or massage at camp.**

Bridle fitting Helen Reader - Helen is Master Saddler, Master Bridle Maker, Master Harness Maker and Master Saddle Fitter Registered Qualified Bridle Fitter – One of the first eight members of the Society of Master Saddlers gain this qualification. [HR Saddlery – Saddle fitting, saddle sales, bespoke bridgework repairs.](#) **Helen will be offering individual sessions for bridle fitting advice, suggestions for improved fit of your current bridle(s) that you can take to your own saddler or leave with her and she'll post adjusted pieces back to you. If you'd like Helen to make you a made to measure bridle, she would take your horse's measurements away with her. She also makes other things including dog collars!**



Rider mindset - Amelia Collins - As well as being a Level 4 Accredited Professional Event Coach, Amelia Collins Equestrian is also a Sport Psychologist (SEPiT - ReAlign Sport Psychology Consultancy). Amelia delivers sessions on all manner of topics including but not limited to, performing under pressure, developing feel and focus without overthinking, managing nerves and competition anxiety, building confidence and self-belief. **Amelia Collins will give a rider mindset talk on the Saturday evening.**
